The Current RRI denotes the current level of media and stakeholder attention of a company related to ESG issues. The RRI ranges from zero (lowest) to 100 (highest). The higher the value, the higher the risk exposure:</p> <p>0-25 = low risk exposure 26-49 = medium risk exposure</p> <p>* NOTE: It is expected that most large multinationals have an RRI between 26-49, due to their global footprint and salience visà-vis media and stakeholders.</p> <p>50-59 = high risk exposure 60-74 = very high risk exposure 75-100 = extremely high risk exposure</p> <p>* NOTE: The RRI is calibrated in such a way that only the handful of companies that are extremely exposed ever reach this threshold, helping users to easily identify these companies</p> <p>Note: An RRI of 0 denotes one of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) it was once above 0 (i.e. RepRisk has captured risk incidents for the company) however, the RRI has since decayed.
